- To take the ACCESS program few steps forward with advanced techniques and focused participants

Eligibility

The applicants must be:

- minimum 13 years of age at the start of the program (October 2021) and maximum 16 years at the end of the program (March 2023).
- a middle/secondary school student until the end of the program
- from a lower income class
- studying at a government or low-income private school and not an elite private school
- having basic communication in the English language
- committed and passionate to learn the English language
- ready to dedicate needed time for the entire duration of the program

Submission Requirements

The applicant is required to submit the following supporting documents.
