- 370 hours of teaching/learning over two years (Program Starts December 2019 and ends April 2021)
- Classes 3-4 days every week (preferably Mondays – Thursdays 3 to 5pm & on alternate Saturdays)
- Venue is The Cowasjee School – NED University of Engineering & Technology
- Available seats 150 to be filled through application and screening of applicants
- Certification by US Consulate, Karachi

Students aged between 13-18 enrolled in a school (Cowasjee School – NEDUET will be preferred) from underserved/economically disadvantaged community of Karachi (residing preferably within the vicinity and surrounding areas), and having basic English language skills and committed to complete 370 hours of teaching and learning for a period of two years
